Native Perennial Plants (grown from seed): Note:

Because these are seed-grown, they are small in size. The peat pots will help reduce transplant shock as you can plant the whole pot.

Brassica Crops and Greens *Special Note*

These crops are either done in single variety packs of 4 plants or mixes of the available varieties, as denoted below

Cauliflower: *Early Snowball* (as single-variety 4-pack OR as split, 2 Cauliflower with 2 of 1 Broccoli variety)

Broccoli: *Gypsy, Marathon, DiCicco* (as split, 2 of 1 variety with 2 of another OR as split 2 of 1 variety with 2 Cauliflower)

Kohlrabi: *White Vienna, Purple Vienna* (as split, 2 Purple and 2 White per 4-pack)

Brussels Sprouts: *Long Island Improved* (as single-variety 4-pack)

Kale/ Greens: *Red Russian, Lacinato, Darkibor, Champion* (Collards), *Five-Colored Silverbeet* (Swiss Chard) (As split, 1 of each 3 Kale varieties, plus 1 Champion OR as single-variety 4-pack of Swiss Chard)

Cabbage: *Early Jersey Wakefield, Red Express* (as split, 2 Early Jersey with 2 Red Express)

Asian Cabbage: *Bilko* (Napa Cabbage), *Prize Choy* (Pac Choy) (As single-variety 4-packs or as split, 2 Bilko with 2 Prize Choy)
